Investors are buying up entire estates to rent out at huge rents. Anyone able to buy their home today has to rent from faceless and ruthless capitalist investors who care only about profit.

of 600 million euro already!) and encourages
them to push up rents
to unaffordable levels
condemning hundreds
of thousands of families
to poverty. This money

Many families are paying rents higher than their mortgage repayment would be on their home but so long as it is profitable for landlords to continue this situation the crisis will not end. The government's socalled solution is to privatise housing completely. This has never worked and will never work.

### NO TO RACISM

Migrants, immigration and refugees are not the cause of this crisis. Attacking immigrants and refugees in direct provision will not stop the

crisis. What it will do is divert energy away from the

true culprits in this crisis: the Irish capitalist class of landlords, bankers, developers and politicians.

Maximum unity of the working class, including migrants and refugees, and the trade unions, building a mass movement though demonstrations, boycotts, resisting evictions and taking strike action is the only way to end this crisis. We need a revolution to overthrow the current corrupt system.

- Phase out HAP instead build new homes with this money!
- Mass public housing programme NOW!
