Our hope is that Iraqi resistance spreads throughout the Arab world.

The US calculated on a short war that did not de-stabilise Arab regimes which it controls. That calculation could soon prove wrong.

AT HOME we need to keep up our resistance to Ahern. He hoped that the issue Shannon could be buried after a short Dail debate and political life would then return to nor-

He hoped that the anti-war movement could be broken on a feeling of powerlessness.

But he calculated wrongly. The

movement is growing stronger and is combining mass demonstrations with civil disobedience.

Next Wednesday has been designated a Day of Action. We need to call protests on pro-war TDS and US oil companies and stage a mass gathering at the Dail in the evening.

THE ROOTS of this war lie in a system that puts profit before people.

Bush wants to turn Iraq into an oil colony for US multi-nationals. He wants US and British companies to dominate the region - and has already handed out 're-construction' contracts to big companies like Halliburton (where Dick Cheney was boss) and Bechtel.

Corporate America will spend \$100 billion on this war - because they see

long term profits.

But they will not spend that amount of money on eradicating disease even though it could save the lives of 30 million people.

This is the crazy logic of capitalism.

Alongside the anti-war movement we need a strong socialist organisation which brings fundamental change. Get involved today.

Do you think people should come before profit?
