



ANARCHO SYNDICALISM IN PUERTO REAL by the Solidarity Federation (Britain) "They haven't gone away you know" as Gerry Adams was once heard to remark.. There are many thousands of anarchists in the CNT and CGT anarcho syndicalist unions in Spain. This pamphlet documents the massive struggle and community resistance against the Spanish governments "rationalisation " plans for the shipyards in Puerto Real. The struggle continues.. £1.00

STALIN DIDN'T FALL FROM THE MOON! a collection of articles from the Workers Solidarity Movement on the Russian revolutions and its destruction at the hands of Lenin & Trotsky. A WSM pamphlet. £1.80

THE BOLSHEVIKS AND WORKERS CONTROL by Maurice Brinton..a very detailed work that sets out to discover what workers control really is, and why state capitalism rather than socialism triumphed in Russia. How the working class took control through their own factory committees and soviets, and how this was taken away from them. Brinton explains how and why. Bolshevik control was not the same thing as workers' control. Essential reading for anyone who wants to know what happened to the liberatory revolution of 1917 and what prepared the way for the dictatorship to come to power. £3.95

THE EXPERIENCE OF THE FACTORY COMMIT-TEES IN THE RUSSIAN REVOLUTION. A pamphlet detailing the experiences of the factory committees and how they organised Russian industry before their defeat by the new Bolshevik bosses. Not as detailed as the Brinton book but still plenty of information. £0.80

ANARCHISM & THE E.Z.L.N An anarchist analysis of the Zapatistas alongside the substantial 1994

interview with Marcos by US and Mexican anarchists. A *WSM* pamphlet. £1.50

THE WORKERS OPPOSITION by Alexandra Kollonti ...Kollanti, a leading Bolshevik, was also a leader of the worker's oppossition within the Bolshevik party. Their pamphlet clearly illustrates how far from workers' control Russia had already moved by 1920s. The



pamphlet provides an excellent introduction and footnotes. £2.50

THE BOLSHEVIK MYTH by Alexander Berkman..the defeat of the great ideas that inspired the revolutionaries of 1917. £4.00

HISTORY OF THE MAKHNOVIST MOVEMENT by Piotr Arshinov...the struggle of the Ukrainian anar-

chists to make the revolution and defend it from both the Tsarists and the new rulers in the Bolshevik party. A piece of history the remains of the authoritarian left still try to keep hidden. A gripping book. £5.00

THE KRONSTADT UPRISING by Ida Mett....the first workers' uprising against the bureaucracy in Russia. What the workers and sailors wanted, and the bloody response of the Bolsheviks. £1.80

THE STRÜGGLE AGAINST THE STATE AND OTHER ESSAYS by Nestor Makhno. Makhno fought the might of Tsarism and eventually the Bolsheviks and for three years held much of the Ukraine under the banner of anarchism. These essays date from his later exile in Europe and deal with the Russian revolution as well as his *platformist* ideas on organisation. £7.95



KRONSTADT IN THE RUSSIAN REVOLUTION by Efim Yartchuk. The author, an elected member of the Kronstadt Soviet and veteran of the 1905 and 1917 revolutions, tells the heroic tale of the Kronstadt garrison from the overthrow of Tsarism to their eventual defeat by the new Bolshevik dictatorship. £3.00

HUNGARY 1956 by Andy Anderson. Superb history of the revolution and the workers councils. £3.95

WORLD WAR - COLD WAR. Articles from the British anarchist 'Freedom' paper during and after the Second World War. £6.95

PORTUGAL: THE IMPOSSIBLE REVOLUTION by Phil Mailer. Eyewitness account of the 1974 revolution which overthrew the military dictatorship. £5.00

MY VISIT TO THE KREMLIN by Nestor Makhno. The Ukranian anarchist visits Lenin at the Kremlin in 1918. He was not impressed. £1.00


